Project Youth Extension Service

A partnership between the Cooperative Extension System and the Department of Defense has provided the funding for a national youth and professional development internship program. Through this initiative, college students have the opportunity to develop professional skills in youth development, small and large group facilitation, critical thinking, and program management and to gain critical hands-on experience working with military children, youth, and families.
