Youth Market Turkey Show



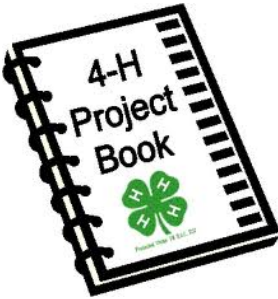

N.C. A&T State University Small Farms Week Youth Essay Contest

The 2020 NC A&T Small Farms Week Youth Essay Competition topic is "How has NC Agriculture affected your life today?" The competition is open to 6th, 7th & 8th grade 4-H'ers across the state. All essays must be computer generated and 1-page in length. Submissions will be judged on content (50 points), grammar/spelling (15 points) and originality/creativity (35 points). 4-H'ers should include their name, grade level, name of Agent and the county they reside in on their essay. The deadline for submission is **8:00 am on Monday, March 16, 2020**. Prizes will be awarded to the top two students in each grade level.
