



Guilford County 4-H Undergraduate Summer Internship

Organization Description North Carolina Cooperative Extension is a partnership between North Carolina's land-grant universities, N.C. A&T State University in Greensboro and N.C. State University in Raleigh. In North Carolina, Cooperative Extension operates in all counties and the Eastern Band of Cherokee. 4-H is the youth development component of N.C. Cooperative Extension and serves youth ages 5-18 in the areas of STEM and Agriculture, Healthy Living, and Civic Engagement and Leadership. In addition to residential summer camp, Guilford County 4-H hosts a variety of day camps and activities throughout the year.

Role Description The Guilford County 4-H Summer Intern will assist the 4-H Agents in planning, implementation, and evaluation of youth summer programs. There will also be opportunities to design and deliver sessions with help from Agents as needed. Collaboration across program areas within Cooperative Extension is vital to the success of our summer day camps, so interns will be able to work closely with Agents in Family & Consumer Science (including financial literacy and health/wellness), Horticulture, and Community & School Gardens. Additionally, there will be opportunities to partner and learn from community leaders.

The intern in this role will also be responsible for assisting in delivery of programming within the AgSTEM Integrated Skills Institute. This programming is intended for youth in Grades 3-5 and integrates STEM concepts into agricultural curriculum to allow for a hands-on, real-world approach to learning and problem-solving for the issues of the future.

Minimum Requirements Excellent verbal and written communication skills; experience working with diverse populations; ability to work independently; ability to handle multiple demands and set priorities; reliable transportation; must be able to lift and carry supplies needed for programs; some sessions will be held outdoors, must be able to be present for outdoor activities during the summer; proficiency in basic technology and software

Selected applicants will be subject to background check and screening

Preferred Requirements Experience in program design, delivery, and evaluation; knowledge of Cooperative Extension program areas and offerings; education or experience in youth education/development, specifically with limited-resource youth; ability to manage time and resources effectively
