Some best practices for growing plants in containers:

- Give your container gardens the advantage of the best sunlight you have available.
- Containers can be new or repurposed be creative! But all containers must have drainage holes.
- Use a pot big enough for the size of the mature plant's root system. Remember plants need room to grow.
- Use a potting mix in containers, not soil from your yard or garden; there are many choices on the market.
- Check the Planting Calendars or seed package for the best information on when to plant.
- When direct seeding, plan for thinning to the correct spacing for the plant's mature size.
- When choosing transplants, look for healthy plants that are not spindly, overgrown, or rootbound.
- Container plantings need regular tending. Pay particular attention to the watering needs of each container. Plants will need more water in summer heat or drought, as well as when they are bigger and more mature. Water thoroughly each time. Remember larger and non-porous containers help to hold moisture longer.
