Yoshino Cherry - *Prunus yedoensis*
Dogwoods - *Cornus florida*, *Cornus kousa*
Eastern Redbud - *Cercis canadensis* var. 'Carolina Sweetheart'
Serviceberry - *Amelanchier grandiflora* var. 'Autumn Brilliance'
Southern Magnolia - *Magnolia grandiflora* var. 'Little Gem'
Swamp Magnolia - *Magnolia virginiana*
Saucer Magnolia - *Magnolia soulangeana*
Crape Myrtle - *Lagerstroemia indica* var. 'Acoma'

SHRUBS:

Chaste Tree - *Vitex agnus castus*
Glossy Abelia - *Abelia grandiflora*, var. 'Kaleidoscope', 'Mardi Gras'
Andromeda - *Pieris japonica* var. 'Mountain Flame'
Azalea and Rhododendron (*Rhododendron* spp.) - Encore® hybrid azaleas, and var. 'George Tabor'
Beautyberry - *Callicarpa americana*
Camellia - *Camellia japonica* var. 'Greensboro Red', *Camellia sasanqua* var. 'Yuletide'
Clethra - *Clethra alnifolia* var. 'Sixteen Candles', 'Rosea'
Virginia sweetspire - *Itea virginica* var. Henry's garnet
Carolina sweetshrub - *Calycanthus floridus*
Pearl bush - *Exochorda x macrantha*
Japanese kerria - *Kerria japonica*
Forsythia - *Forsythia x intermedia*
Gardenia - *Gardenia jasminoides* var. 'Kleim's Hardy', 'Frost Proof'
Big leaf hydrangea - *Hydrangea macrophylla* (mophead and lacecap) var. 'Endless Summer'
Oakleaf hydrangea - *Hydrangea quercifolia* var. 'Snow Queen', 'Snowflake', 'Pee Wee', 'Ruby Slippers'
Panicum hydrangea - *Hydrangea paniculata* var. 'Limelight', 'Little Lime', 'Pee Gee'
Smooth hydrangea - *Hydrangea arborescens* var. 'Annabelle'
Loropetalum - *Loropetalum chinense* var. 'Purple Pixie', 'Plum Delight'
Roses - *Rosa* spp., var. 'Sunsprite', 'Mr. Lincoln', 'Knock out®'
Rose of Sharon - *Hibiscus syriacus*
Bridal Wreath Spirea - *Spirea vanhouttei*
Japanese Spirea - *Spirea japonica* var. 'Limemound', 'Goldmound'
